

Be Unit project - General Framework


Be Unit is a youth policy project co-financed by the Erasmus+ programme under KA220 – Cooperation Partnerships.



Shared Governance Model

Establish a non-adult-driven governance structure in which young people and NGOs co-decide and co-manage the key milestones of the Festival.

Bottom-Up Decision-Making
